DESCRIPTION

The Santa Cruz Route 1 Capital Preventive Maintenance (CAPM) project is located on Route 1 through the City of Santa Cruz from just south of the junction of Route 9 to just north of the Western Drive intersection. The project will include the rehabilitation of just over 8 miles of flexible Class 2 pavement using CAPM strategies including digouts, profile grinding, cold plane, and placing rubberized hot mix asphalt overlay. It will also upgrade 30 sign panels, replace over 500 ft. of Class II bike lane, add ladder markers to enhance the visibility of 6 crosswalks, upgrade 91 curb ramps, and replace damaged intersection detectors.

CONSTRUCTION

To minimize traffic delays during the day through the busy corridor, nighttime construction will be necessary for the majority of construction activities. As a result, high nighttime noise levels are anticipated at times. Since construction for this project will be a moving operation, noise will vary throughout the process and high noise levels at each receptor will be short term. Appropriate and effective measures will be implemented, and additional public outreach will be held prior to construction.

PURPOSE & NEED

The purpose of this project is to improve assets in poor condition, including the roadway, curb ramps and extensions, guardrail, bike lanes, sign panels, crosswalks, and loop detectors. The need is to prevent continued deterioration of these assets, which could lead to service disruption through Route 1 and more frequent maintenance activities. The project will also improve safety by adding curb extensions, ADA standard curb ramps, and improving crosswalk visibility.
