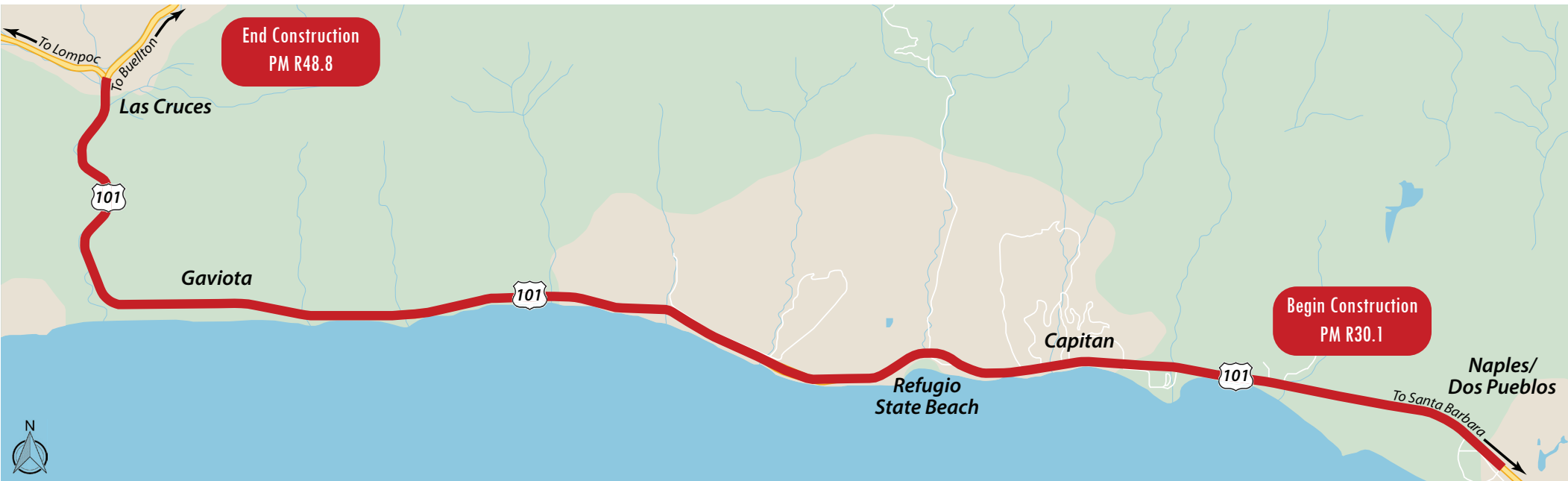


# Dos Pueblos to Gaviota CAPM

Santa Barbara County - Highway 101 - Post Mile R30.1/R48.8



## Description

The Dos Pueblos to Gaviota Capital Preventative Maintenance (CAPM) project is located on Highway 101 from the Dos Pueblos Creek undercrossing to just south of the Gaviota tunnel. The project will include preserving 65.3 lane miles of Class II Pavement, rehabilitating lighting, replacing sign panels, and upgrading guardrail to Manual for Assessing Safety Hardware (MASH) Standards.

## Purpose & Need

The purpose of this project is to preserve and extend the life of the existing pavement, rehabilitate existing lighting to maintain nighttime visibility, and replace sign panels to meet current Federal Highway Association (FHWA) Standards. The project is needed because the pavement is exhibiting deterioration, which left untreated will continue and result in higher maintenance costs. Current sign panels are in poor condition and do not meet FHWA reflectivity standards, and current lighting fixtures are at the end of their service life. Additionally, slope stabilization is needed because of guardrail replacement.
