Document Description	The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to modify the existing State Route 99/State Route 233 interchange by constructing two roundabouts at the ramp intersections in the City of Chowchilla. Each roundabout will be constructed with two circulating lanes on the eastbound and westbound directions. The existing State Route 233 bridge over State Route 99 will remain in place to accommodate the east-bound traffic. A new separate concrete bridge will be constructed for westbound traffic. This new bridge will be constructed north of the existing structure and will have a 10-foot-wide sidewalk, 8-foot-wide outside shoulder, two 12-foot-wide lanes, and a 5-foot-wide inside shoulder.
