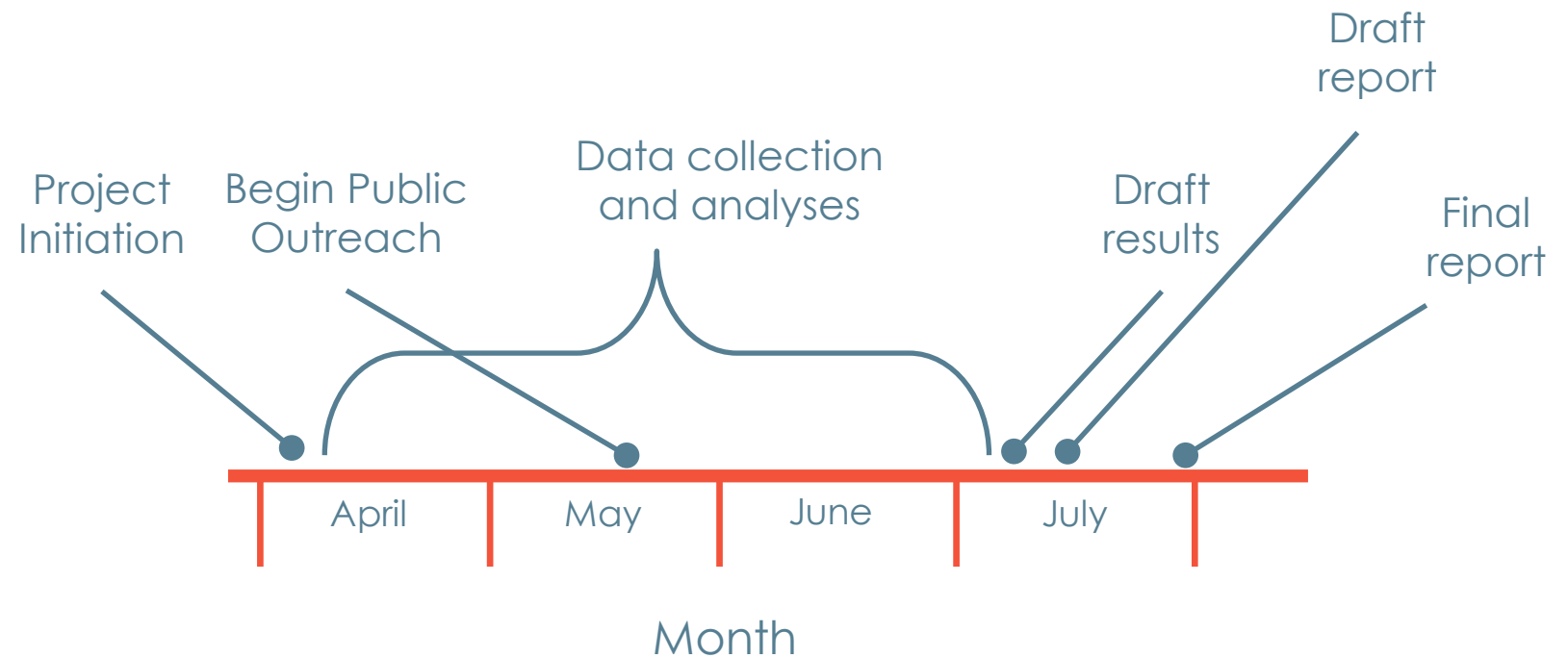
$$\frac{\text{M/WBE participation}}{\text{M/WBE availability}} = \text{DISPARITY INDEX}$$

.80 = *substantial* underutilization

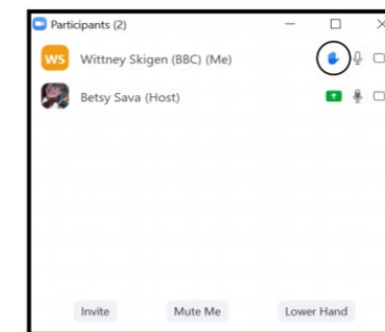
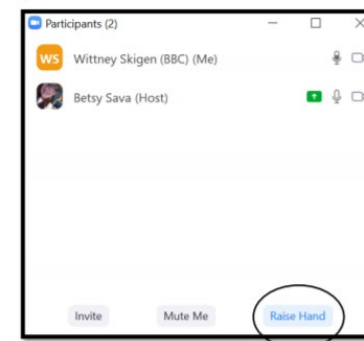
