## I-5 NORTH CONNECTOR TO WESTBOUND SR-22 TO BE CLOSED AT NIGHT FOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

**Orange** — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a \$774,400 improvement project on the connector from northbound Interstate 5 to westbound State Route 22 next week, requiring night closures Mondays through Fridays.

The project will replace concrete slabs, resurface the pavement, and install new lighting. It is designed to smooth the road surface, improve visibility and provide better drainage on the connector. Work will begin Monday, July 31, and is scheduled Mondays-Thursdays from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. and Fridays from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. The project has 60 scheduled working days. Every effort will be made to minimize the impacts of construction to motorists.

The contractor is Autobahn Construction of Orange.
