REVISED - CLOSURE OF WESTBOUND SR-22 CONNECTOR TO THE NORTHBOUND I-5 & NORTHBOUND SR-57 INTERCHANGE

Irvine— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the Westbound SR-22 connector to the Northbound I-5 and Northbound SR-57 Interchange Sunday, July 15th from 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the City of Santa Ana. This is an emergency closure to repair guardrail.

During the closure, overhead lighting work and landscaping maintenance will be completed. Changeable message signs will be posted to alert motorists.

Recommended detours:

Westbound SR-22 traffic wanting to transition to Northbound I-5 must exit the City Drive, turn right on Metropolitan Drive, left on the City Drive and turn right onto the Northbound I-5 onramp.

Westbound SR-22 traffic wanting to transition to Northbound SR-57 must exit the City Drive, turn right on Metropolitan Drive, left on the City Drive and turn right Chapman Avenue to reach the Northbound SR-57 onramp.
