



# VISITORS GUIDE

**The Antlers Bridge Replacement Project** is expected to be of high interest to many personnel within Caltrans, our Federal, State and Local agency partners, and the press. We expect that many people will want to visit this project as it progresses, either to ensure compliance with various federal, state, or local agency requirements or to observe the construction process.

Caltrans, along with our contractor partners, want to ensure that our project site maintains the highest level of safety at all times. Therefore, we have established some basic rules for anyone wishing to visit the site.

- ◆ **Please phone 238-2966 or e-mail [eric\\_akana@dot.ca.gov](mailto:eric_akana@dot.ca.gov)** prior to your visit.
- ◆ **Please check in at the Caltrans Resident Engineer's Office** at 18300 Antlers School Road. A quick review of the Code of Safe Practices for the ongoing activity that day will be discussed with you prior to entry into the construction area. An escort will be provided to ensure that you have safe access in the construction area.
- ◆ **Please bring your personal protection equipment.** Per the Caltrans Safety Manual all visitors will be required to wear, at a minimum, a hardhat, safety vest and safety glasses. Hearing protection may be required as well. You will not be allowed to enter the construction zone without this equipment. A minimal amount of safety equipment may be available at the resident engineer's office.

Your cooperation is necessary for everyone's safety. Your efforts in following these basic rules will ensure that we maintain the safest job possible.
