Addendum No. 1

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in SAN DIEGO COUNTY AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on August 7, 2008.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-3.10, "MICROWAVE VEHICLE DETECTION SYSTEM – SIDE FIRE," subsection "FUNCTIONAL REQUIREMENTS," the fifth paragraph, item No. 2, is revised as follows:

"The MVDS shall support the Wavetronix SS125HD data protocol or the EIS RTMS (data) protocol version 7.1, or demonstrated equal."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-3.10, "MICROWAVE VEHICLE DETECTION SYSTEM – SIDE FIRE," subsection "TESTING," the first, second and third paragraphs are replaced with the following paragraphs:

"Successful completion of the Preliminary Functional Test of the MVDS equipment is required at Locations 57 and 34 prior to MVDS equipment being installed at any other location. Location 57 and 34, shall be used as the test locations for Installation Type A and Type B, respectively. Successful completion of the Preliminary Functional Test for any type of Installation (A or B), allows MVDS equipment (same manufacturer, make and model) to be installed at the remaining Locations of the same type.

Preliminary Functional Test: Prior to installing MVDS equipment at other locations, the two test locations shall be used to confirm that the MVDS equipment is operational on the photovoltaic power supply, is functional with protocol accepted by the Engineer, and has acceptable output to a local Windows 2000/NT or newer compatible laptop. Microwave Vehicle Detection System equipment shall be tested while on photovoltaic power only. Video recording and the transmission of MVDS traffic data to a central computer or to the Traffic Management Center (TMC) computer are not required for this test.

Final Location Acceptance Test: At each location the Contractor shall perform accuracy tests of the Microwave Vehicle Detection Systems. The Contractor shall provide satisfactory test results to the Engineer prior to completing the Final Location Acceptance Test."

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To Proposal and Contract book holders:

Inquiries or questions in regard to this addendum must be communicated as a bidder inquiry and must be made as noted in the NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS section of the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

Indicate receipt of this addendum by filling in the number of this addendum in the space provided on the signature page of the proposal.

Submit bids in the Proposal and Contract book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.

Inform subcontractors and suppliers as necessary.
