
**Subject: Otay Mesa Road Rehabilitation Project**

This is in response to your request for water availability for the Otay Mesa Road Rehabilitation Project. Based upon the volume and duration of the project you provided, the City of San Diego has sufficient and available capacity to serve your project during the construction. A temporary construction meter connected to a fire hydrant can be installed during the construction if you decide to connect to City of San Diego's water main in Otay Mesa Road. Please note that existing potable water irrigation meter as well as other existing potable water irrigation meters City-wide will be subject to any City of San Diego City Council drought actions to conserve water, if enacted by City Council.

Please also note that a smaller segment of the water main in Otay Mesa Road is within the City of San Diego Public Utilities Department jurisdiction. This segment is from the beginning of your project to Heritage Road. The majority of your alignment (from Heritage Road all the way to the east) falls within the Otay Water District jurisdiction. You'll need to contact them for their concurrence. Additionally, Otay Water District's reclaimed water is also available in the area and you are encouraged to use reclaimed water for temporary construction purposes if possible.

Dear Ms. Sisson:

Otay Water District (District) is in receipt of your letter dated June 13, 2014 regarding water availability for the proposed construction of the Highway Construction Project at Otay Mesa Road from the area west of Ocean View Hills Parkway to Route 125 (Project).

**Water availability is subject to all District requirements in effect at the time of application. You are strongly encouraged to adopt water conservation measures throughout the development. In response to Governor Brown's declaration of a statewide drought calling on all Californians to save water, the District has declared a Level 1 – Supply Watch Condition. Under a Supply Watch, customers are urged to voluntarily reduce water use by ten (10) percent.**

The District has no objections with providing water for construction purposes for the above-mentioned Project. The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and/or the Construction Contractor working on behalf of Caltrans will be responsible for all costs associated with obtaining temporary construction meter(s) and water usage during construction. The temporary construction meter(s) applications (**TEMPORARY WATER METERS (FOR USE ON HYDRANT)**) can be obtained from the District's web page at [http://www.otaywater.gov/engineering/public\\_services](http://www.otaywater.gov/engineering/public_services).

Prior to the purchase of any permanent meter(s), irrigation plans must be: 1) designed to District's Water Agency Standards for recycled water, and 2) submitted to the District and the County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health for plan check and approval.
