Subject: **APPROVAL OF PROJECT FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION OF FUNDING  
NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE 10<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE WIDENING/RECONSTRUCTION -  
THIRD STREET TO HANFORD-ARMONA ROAD PROJECT  
(RESOLUTION E-12-38)**

## **ISSUE:**

Should the Commission, as a Responsible Agency, accept the Negative Declaration (ND) for the 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue Widening/Reconstruction –Third Street to Hanford-Armona Road Project (project) in the City of Hanford and approve the project for future consideration of funding?

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the Commission accept the ND and approve the project for future consideration of funding.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The City of Hanford (City) is the CEQA lead agency for the project. The project will widen an existing two lane road to a five lane roadway width arterial including curb, gutter, sidewalk, and street lighting.

On April 12, 2012, the City found that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and mitigation measures are not required, and approved the ND.

The project is estimated to cost \$1,930,000 and is programmed with SLPP (\$750,000) funds and Local (\$1,180,000) funds. Construction is estimated to begin in fiscal year 2012/13.


